- Capital: Brasilia, with 4.2 million inhabitants is the country's fourth largest city. The largest city in Brazil is Sao Paulo with about 12 million inhabitants.

Facts:


- Brazil won more World Cups than any other country (5 times)

- Brazil is the only country with the most goals scored of all time!





