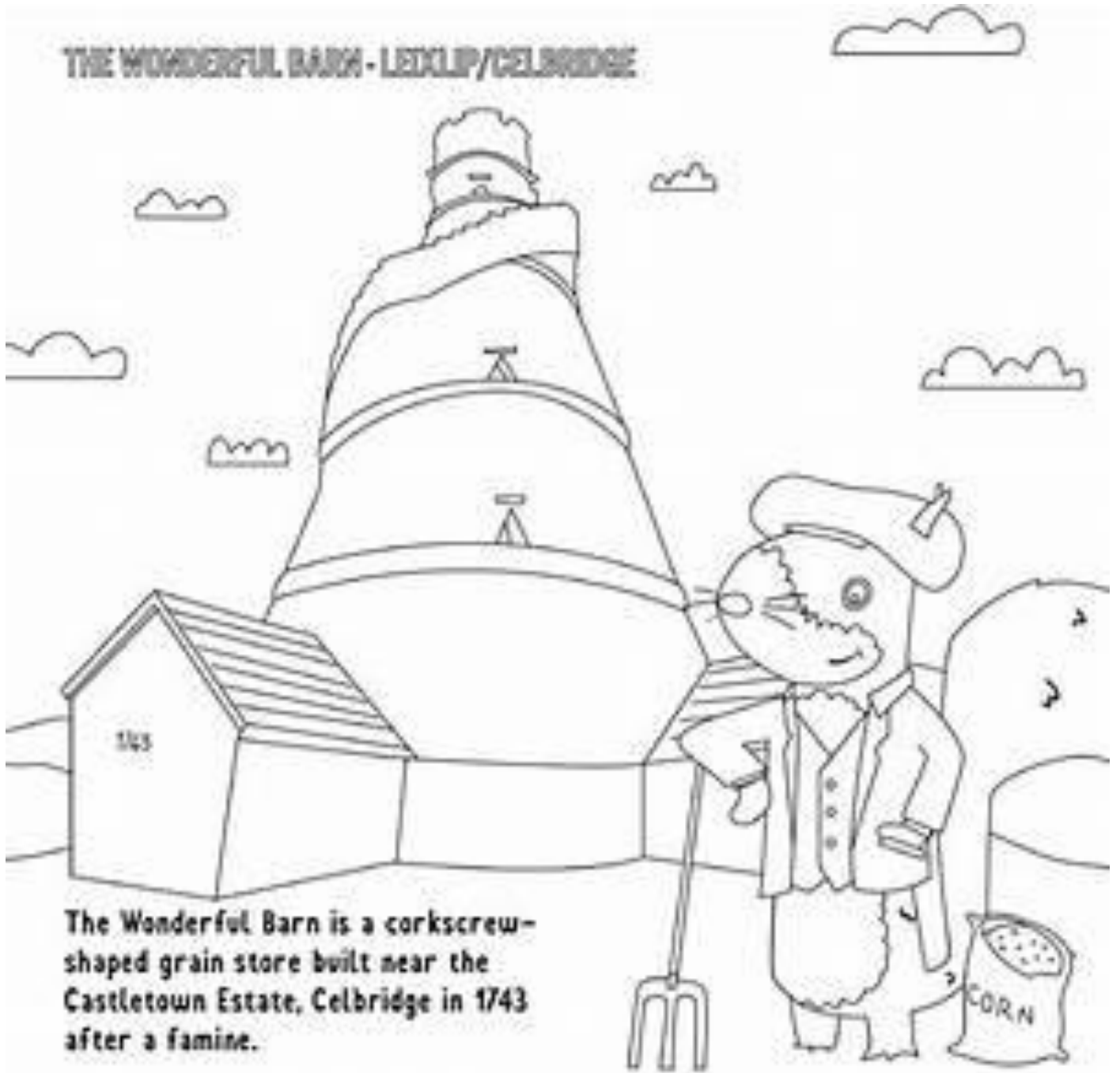
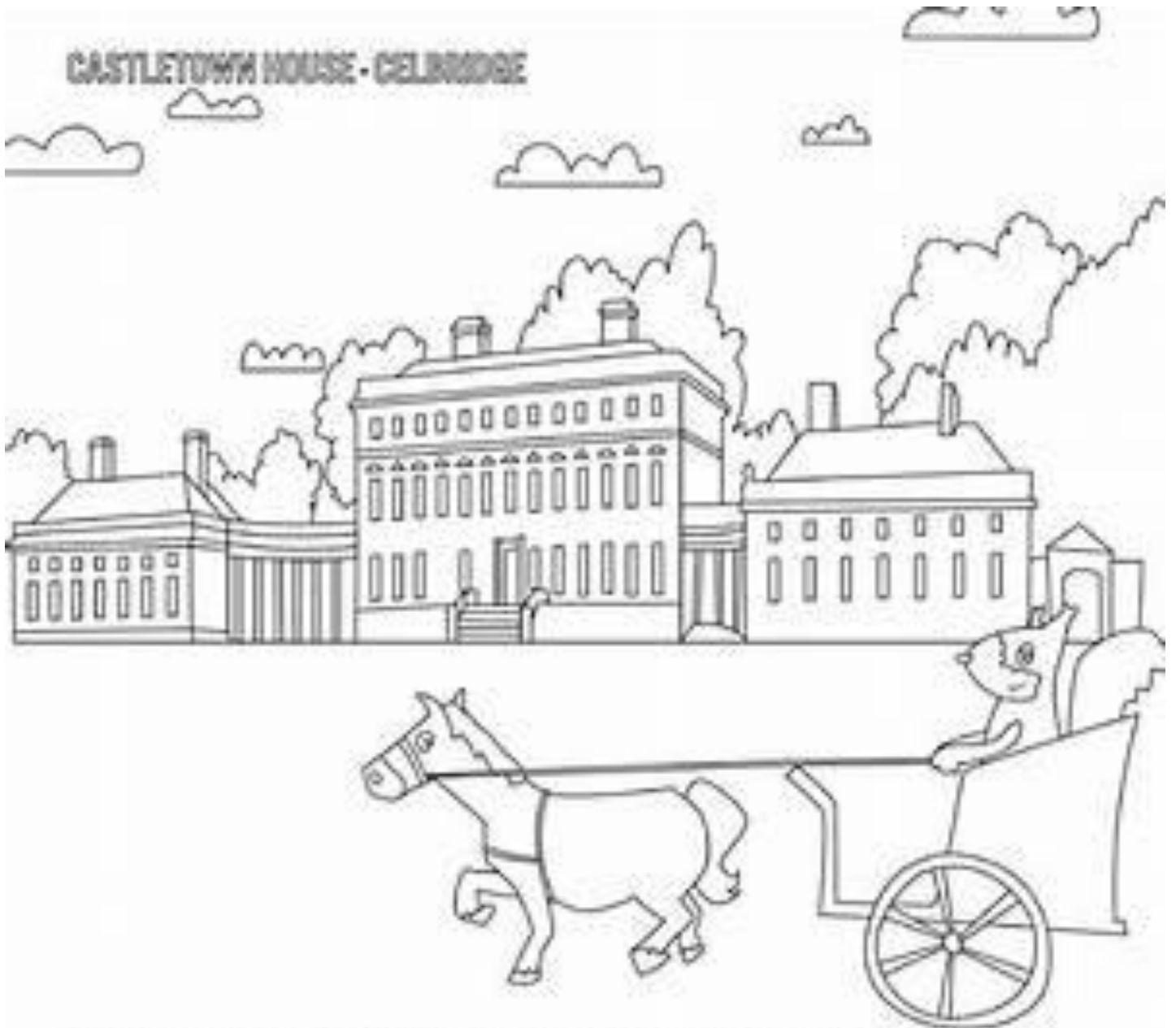


THE WONDERFUL BARN - LEIXLIP/CELBRIDGE



The Wonderful Barn is a corkscrew-shaped grain store built near the Castletown Estate, Celbridge in 1743 after a famine.

CASTLETOWN HOUSE - CELBRIDGE



Castletown House, Celbridge, was built between 1722 and 1729 for William "Speaker" Conolly. The style of the house is Palladian which comes from Italy.

CONOLLY'S FOLLY - CELBRIDGE/WAYFOOTH



Conolly's Folly, or the Obelisk, is 140 metres high and was built by Katherine Conolly of Castletown House in 1740 to provide employment during a famine.
