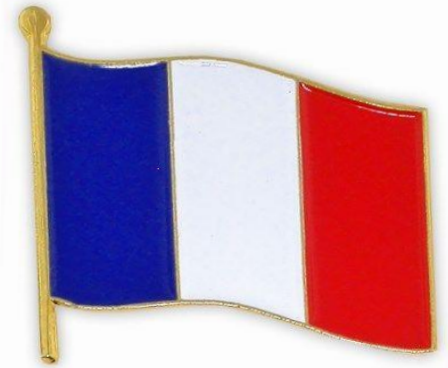

- Nice Carnival.-Major economic benefits from the carnival is estimated to +30 million euros. 3 Parades on place Masséna and Jardin Albert 1er: Day Parade, Night Parade and Flower Parade. 150 animated pieces including a few Grosses Têtes (Big Heads) 17 floats, 12m long x 3m wide, up to 17m high.
