- Timekeeping: Please make sure your child is on time for school each morning (9.15-9.25).
- If your child must leave school early, please come to the main door and sign the 'sign out' book.
- We are a Green School so try to avoid bringing tin foil, cling film and cartons. Try to
 walk or cycle to school especially on Wednesdays. Bring used batteries for the battery
 box.
- Healthy Lunches: In line with our healthy lunch policy, children should bring a healthy lunch to school please do not bring crisps, sweets, cakes, fizzy drinks.
- Nut-free school: please do not send food containing nuts (such as chocolate spread) in your child's lunchbox. We have a number of children in the school with nut allergies.
- Please ensure that homework is completed and signed every night by an adult.
- Please pay school payments to the office by the end of next week if you haven't done so already.
