- We are a **Green School** so try to avoid bringing tin foil, cling film and cartons. Try to walk or cycle to school, especially on Wednesdays.
- Healthy Lunches: In line with our healthy lunch policy, children should bring a healthy lunch to school please do not bring crisps, sweets, cakes or fizzy drinks.
- Nut-free school: Please do not send food containing nuts (such as chocolate spread) in your child's lunchbox. We have a number of children in the school with nut allergies.
- Please ensure that homework is completed and signed every night by an adult.
- Please pay school payments to the office by the end of next week if you haven't done so already.
