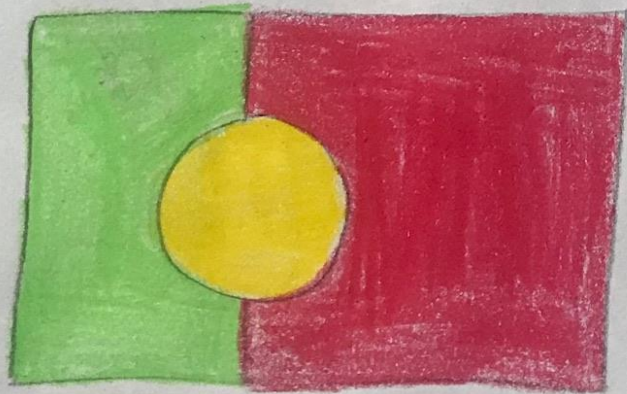

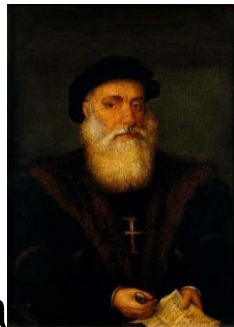

- The Capelinha das Aparições marks the spot where the Virgin Mary appeared in 1917.



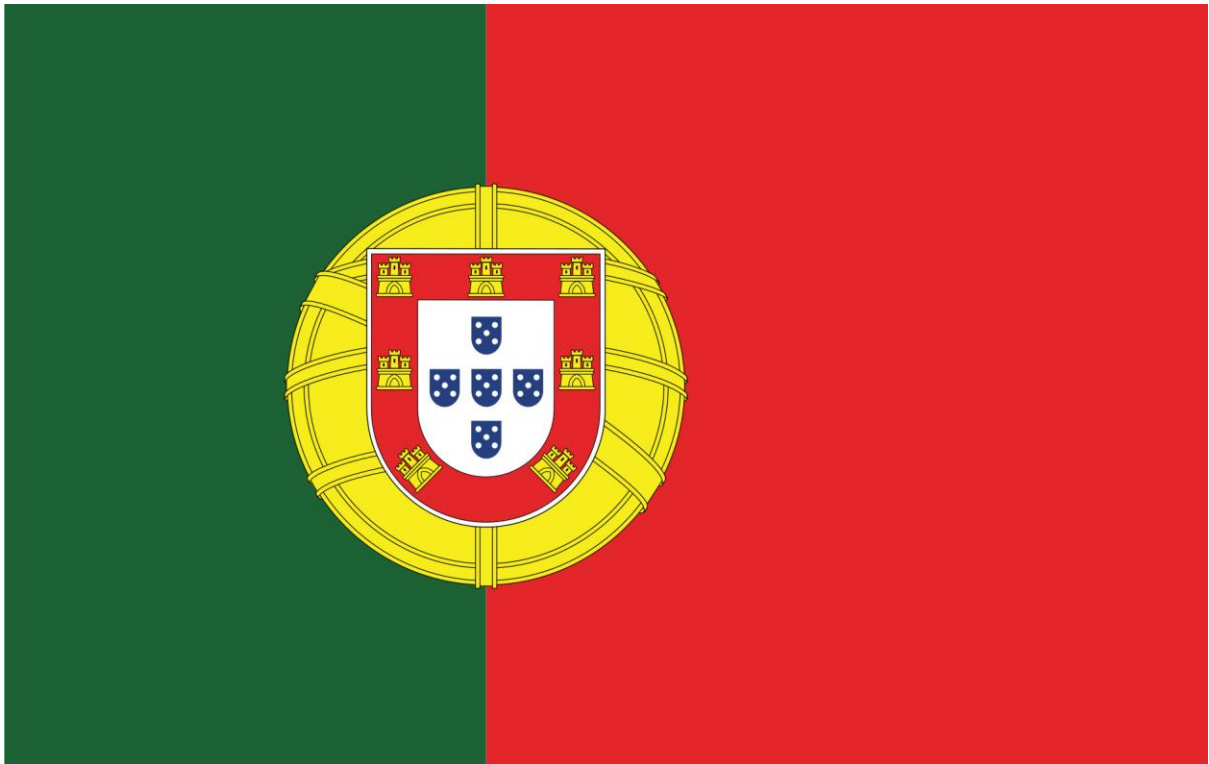
Portugal is split up into seven different regions
