- Penguins spend around half their time in water and the other half on land.

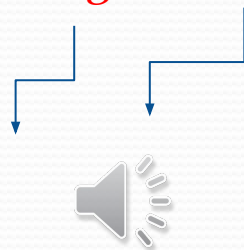

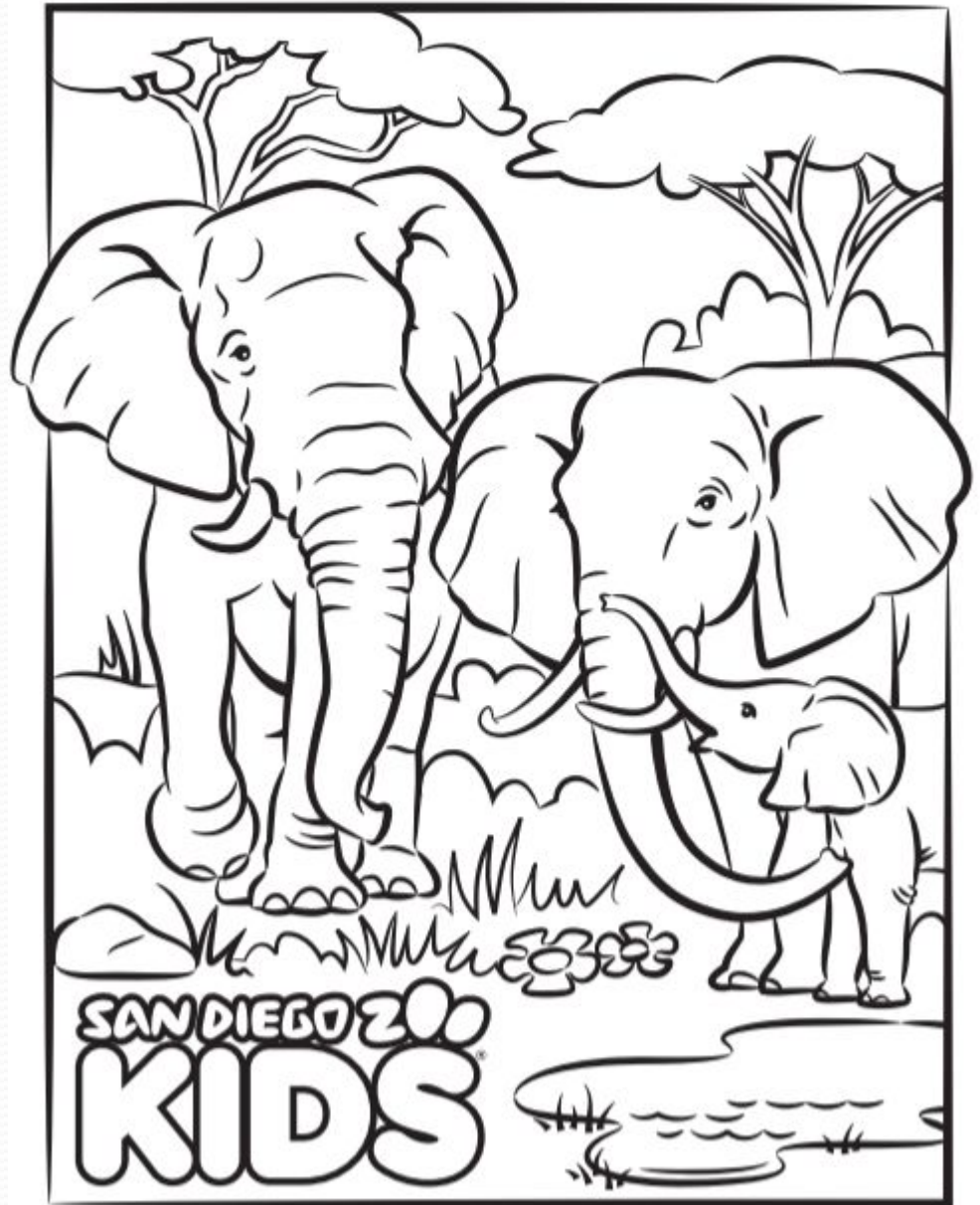

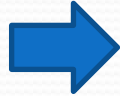
